# Types of School Supplies Needed: One School's Wish List

<b>Item (bold = greatest need)</b>	<b>Details</b>	<b>Quantity requested for 1 school (double to cover both schools)</b>	<b>Purchased?</b>
<b>Toner Cartridges</b>	CE505A - HP Printers. For shared, communal school printer	8 will probably take us through the school year	
<b>Colored paper</b>	not-too-dark colors we can print on but nice if not just pastels, bright yellow, light blue, lime green, etc.; helpful to get ream that is one color each - used for pages they refer back to often	60 reams all different colors	
<b>Copy Paper</b>		28 cases (280 reams) to get through the year	
<b>Post-it brand poster sized pads of white paper</b>	These are expensive. Only get if you have a way to purchase at a discount or feel really compelled by this ask	20	
<b>chart paper tablets</b>	If you don't want to get the expensive Post-it brand ones, we will make do with any chart paper! None available currently in our school	25 pads	
<b>card stock</b>	bright colors we can print on - we use to make bookmarks for kids, things that get used over and over	60 reams	
<b>dry erase expo markers - the thick ones</b>	These are the expo regular markers. We use all the time and black would be especially good to have more of	20	
<b>dry erase markers - thin kind for kids to use</b>	thin markers - ideally black but if cheaper in colors ok!	200	
<b>glue sticks</b>	We tend to use the Elmer's kind with the orange cap - you can get in sets of 30 but any glue sticks will do	60 packs of 30	
<b>staples</b>		20 packs	
<b>staplers</b>		12	
<b>large paper clips</b>		20 packs	
<b>manila folders</b>	letter size - 8&1/2x11	10 boxes	
<b>tissues</b>	parents also bring but doesn't hurt to have extra. less of a priority		
<b>paper towels</b>	parents also bring but doesn't hurt to have extra. less of a priority		
<b>Colored pencils</b>		6 sets of 12 or 24	
<b>Fun pencils (for prizes)</b>		10 packages	
<b>Fiscars Blunt-tip kids scissors</b>		10 scissors	
<b>3" x4" avery tag labels</b>		2 packs
