The Minister of Music is responsible for all musical components of St. John's liturgy. The Minister of Music is expected to play the organ and/or piano at all regularly scheduled services; to recruit, rehearse and conduct volunteer adult and youth choirs in the performance of service music; to oversee the music performed at parish weddings, funerals or other special services; and fulfill other musical responsibilities as requested by the Rector.

#### **Position Detail:**

Working in close cooperation with the rector and other clergy of the parish, the Minister of Music is responsible for:

- Selecting appropriate hymns, anthems and other music for Sunday services each week
- Hiring professional musicians for Christmas, Easter, and other special services
- Ensuring that service music is consistent with the theme of the scripture readings, the sermon and the overall tone of the services
- Developing the musical abilities of the Youth and Chancel Choirs
- Maintaining the choir calendar on the St. John's webpage
- Developing and managing annual Music Budget
